The comments listed below are provided as a result of
our review of the above referenced document:

1. Concur with the findings and recommendations regarding sites 1,2,4,5,8,9 and 14. These sites have been identified as candidates for further investigation during Phase II confirmation studies.
2. Concur in the rationale and conclusion where by sites 3,7,12 and 15 are identified as requiring no further action at this time.
3. Recommend that shallow cores be collected at sites 10 and 16 and tested for PCB contamination and ground-water and soil samples be collected at sites 11 and 13 with as a minimum, analysis for the specific contaminants at the respective sites and optimally a scan for the presence of the entire appendix III priority pollutants at the two sites.
