Dear Mr. Miller:

We are forwarding for your review the proposed Verification Work Plan covering eleven sites on the Naval Station, Mayport, Florida property. The plan was developed by the E. C. Jordan, Company, Tallahassee, Florida under Navy contract. Field investigations will also be performed by this firm.

Should your review of the plan and the recent RFA you conducted at the Naval Station indicate a need to investigate additional sites, it is recommended that they be addressed separately to permit continuation of the work on the eleven sites. A meeting to be held at the Naval Station, Mayport is tentatively scheduled for March 19, 1987. We hope to have in attendance both EPA and FDER representatives to address CERCLA and RCRA requirements with regard to this project.
