The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region IV, has received a letter from the U.S. Navy, Southern Division, NAVFACENCOM, dated May 4, 1992, requesting an extension, to July 10, 1992, for the submission of the Draft RFI Report for the Group I Solid Waste Management Units located on Naval Station Mayport (NAVSTAMAY). EPA approves the request for an extension to July 10, 1992, for the submittal of the Draft RFI Report. However, EPA expects the Navy to make every attempt to keep the final RFI Report on schedule.

As stated in EPA's October 24, 1991, letter to you which approved the Corrective Action Management Plan (CAMP) schedule for NAVSTAMAY, the CAMP satisfies Conditions II.C. and portions of II.G. of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) Permit for NAVSTAMAY and replaces any previous compliance schedules for the facility. In effect, the approved CAMP became an integral component of the HSWA Permit. Changes to the CAMP schedule (such as extensions for dates of submittals) constitute an Administrative and informational change to the HSWA Permit and therefore require a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class I permit modification as provided for in 40 CFR 270.42. The permit modification approved by this letter should be kept with the facility's HSWA Permit.

In accordance with the provisions of 40 CFR 270.42 (a)(ii), you are required to notify all persons on the facility's mailing list of EPA's approval within ninety (90) days from the receipt of this letter. Since 40 CFR 270.42 (a)(ii) specifies that such notifications are to be made after EPA approval has been granted, your notification should reference this letter.

Failure to meet the deadline for the submission of the Draft RFI Report may result in sanctions pursuant to §3008 of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. 6928, consistent with Executive Order 12088, Federal Compliance with Pollution Control Standards.
