Naval Station Mayport (NAVSTA) requests the official transfer of the management and further investigation of SWMUs 29 and 46 to Florida's petroleum contamination site cleanup program (FAC 62-770). These SWMUs are already being investigated under this program as the Alpha/Delta Pier Site and Site 1490, respectively. All analytical results received to date indicate only petroleum contamination at these sites; therefore, there is no need to investigate them under the USEPA HSWA program.
