

Examples of other RAB Charters and Mission Statements handed out; Summary of 2/21 Meeting, CAMP Schedule of 3/95 and List of Major Documents as well as the members' new notebooks were handed out.

General discussion on items to accomplish in up-coming meetings - All members agreed that decisions regarding Community Co-Chair, Member attendance and length of service requirements would be postponed for a few more meetings until everyone gets to know the other members and has a better understanding of the overall RAB process and what is required of the members.
