The Engineering Division of the Staff Civil Engineer Department at the U.S. Naval Station, Mayport, Florida, has requested the Jacksonville District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, to provide Architect/Engineer (A/E) design services for removal of dredged material from upland disposal areas D/A-N and D/A-0. Construction includes the removal of dredged material and separation of recyclable material for use in road asphalt mix, concrete, etc. and disposal of non-recyclable material in a landfill. The intention of this project is to provide capacity for future maintenance dredging of the Mayport basin.

The project is scheduled to start at the end of calendar year 1995 or the beginning of 1996. The project will take approximately 1 year to complete.
