SUBJ: Approval of Corrective Action Management Plan Group II, RCRA Facility Assessment and Confirmatory Sampling Report, Naval Station Mayport, Jacksonville, Florida.

Dear CAPT Cantfill:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), has received and reviewed the Final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Assessment (RFA) Sampling Report for Group II Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) at Naval Station Mayport. Based upon the review, EPA concurs with the recommendation of "no further action" at SWMU 26, Landfill C; SWMU 56, Building 1552 Accumulation Area; SWMU 19, Naval Aviation Depot (NADEP) Blasting Area; SWMU 28, Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office Yard Facility; and SWMU 48, Former Chemistry Laboratory Accumulation Area pursuant to your Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit effective June 15, 1993.

Additionally, EPA concurs with the following determinations for additional investigatory work at SWMUs 49 & 50. In accordance with your RCRA permit, include a submission date for the draft sampling and analysis plans required to conduct the focused RFI ecological assessment in your FY 96 Corrective Action Management Plan update.

- SWMU 50, East and West Dredge Spoil Disposal Areas: Based on the analytical results, ecological diversity measurements and aquatic and sediment toxicity testing are warranted. The final determination for conducting a focused RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) ecological assessment is dependent upon results of the RFI currently being conducted for the Landfill SWMUs 2, 3, 4, and 5 which are located beneath and adjacent to SWMU 50. Final determination pertaining to the need for a focused ecological assessment at SWMU 50 will be made upon review of the Group I RFI report currently under EPA review.

- SWMU 49, Flight Line Retention Ponds EPA concurs that an focused RFI - ecological assessment is required for SWMU 49. The focused RFI is to include ecological diversity and aquatic and sediment toxicity testing to assess whether no further action is warranted or corrective action is required.

EPA's concurrence is predicated on the information provided by the NAVSTA Mayport; therefore, any new information contradicting the basis for this concurrence may require further investigation or corrective actions.
