This is to inform you of four potential Areas of Concern (AOCs) located at Naval Station Mayport (NAVSTA). The sites, on the enclosed list, were identified at the request of the regulatory agency members of the NAVSTA IR Partnering Team. Three sites are potential AOCs due to possible discharges into septic tank systems from potentially "industrial" activities. These include machine shops and paint shops. The extent of activities at these locations is not known and there is no confirmed discharge into the septic systems which is why they are listed as only potential AOCs. The fourth site is near what appears to be an old landfill.

Funding for performance of confirmatory sampling at these sites has been requested from Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command. However, this sampling is currently unfunded for FY97. If funding becomes available, NAVSTA will conduct confirmatory sampling at these sites and forward the assessment reports to your office and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Tallahassee.
