In a January 10, 1995 letter from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), EPA approved the transfer of SWMU 46 to Florida's petroleum contamination site cleanup program (FAC 62-770). This approval was given based on analytical results indicating that only petroleum contaminants were present. However, data submitted to EPA in the Technical Memorandum - Groundwater Assessment of Tetrachloroethene Release Near Building 191 (HLA, January 1999) indicates that there is a potential of a chlorinated solvents release to the groundwater from SWMU 46. Based on this data, EPA has determined that SWMU 46 still requires Confirmatory Sampling under permit condition II.D of the HSWA permit.

Additional required reports must be submitted to this office in accordance with the compliance schedule delineated in NAVSTA Mayport's approved Corrective Action Management Plan (CAMP). Should you have any questions regarding these comments, please contact Martha Berry of my staff at 404.562.8533.
