Site 245 has meet the No Further Action criteria of subsection 62-770.680(1), F.A.C., and the site should be considered for a Site Rehabilitation Completion Order (SRCO) per Rule 62-770.750, F.A.C. An SRCO for No Further Action without institutional controls or without institutional and engineering controls will be issued. However, documentation to support the opinion that soil contamination at the site was remediated to the required FDEP standards could have been improved in this report. Future Site Rehabilitation Completion Reports (SRCRs) should include the documentation required in paragraph 62-770.750(5)(d), F.A.C., to support the opinion that site cleanup objectives have been achieved.
