Dear Ms. Wilson:

I have reviewed the above document dated October 1997 (received November 10, 1997). Additionally, we have discussed it on several occasions with personnel from ABB and the Partnering team also visited the sites at the last meeting.

During a teleconference with Frank Lesesne of ABB and Martha Berry of EPA Region IV earlier this month, we discussed SWMU 4, SWMU 49 and SWMU 50. We discussed the problem with changing regimes of salt water and fresh water and it was decided that ABB will prepare a technical memorandum which documents and discusses the fact that even though the water bodies on SWMU 50 are dredge material settling ponds which intermittently receive discharges of salt water, those water bodies receive fresh rain water which moderates the salinity over time. These ponds are on a major migratory bird flyway and they serve as an important resting area for many different migratory bird species. The technical memorandum will be added to the final report as an addendum. I have discussed this earlier today with Ms. Berry and she is agreeable to this approach.

Other than the above comments, the report is acceptable. Please submit the final appendix materials and I will place them in the document.




