I have reviewed the subject document dated August 7, 2013. It was received on August 8, 2013. The document was completed under Contract Task Order 0033.

The report states that *“Tetra Tech, Inc. is pleased to submit this Technical Report supporting the Navy’s request to transfer Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 55 to the Stormwater Program administered by Naval Station (NAVSTA) Mayport.”* The report goes on to state that *“The stormwater ditches surrounding SWMUs 2, 3, 4, 5, and 22 were transferred to the stormwater program in 2007 according to the January 2007 NAVSTA Mayport Installation Restoration Partnering Team meeting minutes. The stormwater permit programs, initiated after the RFA, regulate the stormwater runoff from both industrial and non-industrial sections of NAVSTA Mayport.”* The report ends by stating *“Tetra Tech recommends transferring SWMU 55 to the stormwater permit program.”*

Based on my review of the report, and NAVSTA Mayport Partnering Team discussions concerning SWMU 55 on December 3, 2013, the Department does not concur with this recommendation. The recommendation that was concurred with during the on board review of SWMU 55 at the December 3 Partnering Team meeting was to complete the SWMU’s Corrective Measures Study (CMS) and Statement of Basis (SB).
