The United States Navy, with the concurrence from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), is proposing final corrective actions for multiple Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) at Naval Station (NAVSTA) Mayport in Jacksonville, Florida.

**Public Notice of Land Use Controls for Soil for SWMUs 2, 3, 4, 5, and 26;
Land Use Controls and
Groundwater Monitoring for
Groundwater for
SWMUs 2, 3, 4, 5, and 22;
and No Action for
Groundwater for SWMU 26**

SWMUs 2, 3, 4, and 5 were landfills operated by the Navy from 1960 to 1985. SWMU 22 was an area where abrasive media was used from 1985 until 1992 for cleaning ground support equipment and vehicles. SWMU 26 was a construction landfill used only in 1963.

The proposed corrective action for soil and buried waste at SWMUs 2, 3, 4, 5, and 26 is to implement Land Use Controls (LUCs) in the form of non residential land use restrictions and soil disturbance restrictions. No action is proposed for the soil at SWMU 22 and the groundwater at SWMU 26. The proposed corrective actions for groundwater at SWMUs 2, 3, 4, 5, and 22 are monitored natural attenuation and the implementation of LUCs in the form of groundwater use/extraction prohibition.

SWMU 8 was the percolation pond used from 1979 to 1994 for SWMU 9, which is the Oily Waste Treatment Plant, constructed in 1979. SWMU 11 was a fuel spill area identified in 1986, located in the NAVSTA Mayport Fuel Farm. SWMU 51 was a trio of Waste Oil cut and cover tanks constructed in 1954 and removed in 2001.

The proposed corrective action for soil at SWMUs 9 and 51 is to implement LUCs for soil in the form of non residential land use restrictions and soil disturbance restrictions. No action is proposed for the soil at SWMUs 8 and 11 and the groundwater at SWMU 11. Additionally, the proposed corrective actions for groundwater at SWMUs 8, 9, and 51 are long-term monitoring and the implementation of LUCs in the form of groundwater use/extraction prohibition.

Soil and Groundwater for SWMUs
18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 52, and 56**

SWMU 18 is a diesel generator sump associated with the Firefighting Training Area. SWMU 19 was an area north of Buildings 1470 and 1471 used for abrasive blasting of unpainted aircraft carrier parts. SWMU 20 was the Hobby Shop Drain, and SWMU 21 was the Hobby Shop Scrap Storage Area located adjacent to Building 414. SWMU 28 was the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office Storage Area. SWMU 52 was an oil-stained area behind Building 25. SWMU 56 was an area adjacent to the 90 day satellite storage area located south of Building 1552.

The proposed corrective action for soil and groundwater at SWMUs 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 52, and 56 is no further action.

A copy of the applicable Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Facility Investigation, Corrective Measures Study, and the Statement of Basis for each of these SWMUs are available for review at the NAVSTA Mayport Information Repository located at the Jacksonville Public Library Beaches Branch.
