Dear Mayor Harvell:

The Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act of 1986 requires all Department of Defense Installation Restoration Program projects to implement a Technical Review Committee (TRC). Along these lines, a TRC is being established for Naval Air Station Memphis. This committee will actively participate in the development of the scope of work for the Remedial Investigation, provide comments and technical review during the execution of the Remedial Investigation, and assist in the selection of remedial technologies based on data gathered by the Navy.

I would like to extend an invitation for you, or a designee assigned by you, to serve as a committee member. In addition, if you could recommend an individual from the local community who would represent the interests of the general public as a committee member, it would be greatly appreciated. Other members will include representatives from the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Tennessee Department of Health and Environment, the Navy, and the local community. I anticipate that the TRC will hold its first meeting in January 1989.
