The Tennessee Division of Solid Waste Management (Division) has received a draft letter by e-mail from NSA titled Land Use Control Termination at Aircraft Fire Fighting Training Facility (Training Facility). Based on the contents of the draft, TDEC approves modification of the Land Use Controls (LUC) for the Training Facility. On April 17, 2003, the Division issued a letter reconfirming that all required remediation activities at SWMU 5 had been completed and that no further action is required. The Navy may remove the LUC that prohibits excavation or any other soil-disturbing activities in the areas previously identified with surface and subsurface soil contamination at the Training Facility Area. This release of deed restriction in no way terminates or modifies any other restrictions on this property or any other property transferred by the Navy. All other deed restrictions including the prohibition of the use and extraction of loess and fluvial deposits groundwater and the prohibition of residential use of the property remain in effect.
