The Division of Solid Waste Management (Division) has reviewed the IM Progress Report for SWMUs 14/47, prepared by EnSafe Inc. and Spetra Tech, Inc. Since injections began, trichloroethylene (TEC) concentrations have remained relatively stable. However, the August 2006 sampling event showed a significant decrease in TCE concentrations from 120 micograms per liter (ug/L) in January 2005 to 68 ug/L in August 2006 in monitoring well 014G14LS. The report concludes that substrate injections should continue on a monthly basis.
