The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division Superfund (DSF) Memphis Field Office (MFO) has reviewed the RCRA Facility Investigation Interim Measures Technical Memorandum for SWMU 45, S-142 Hazardous Waste Accumulation Point for the NAS Memphis site.

The TDEC, upon considering the remedial interim measures performed at SWMU 45 and the sampling indicating that all contamination has been removed below federal and state standards, agrees with the recommendation for No Further Action status proposed on SWMU 45. Moreover, the TDEC concurs with the EPA's decision for No Further Action on SWMU 45 in the letter dated January 19, 1996, received in this office on February 1, 1996.
