Dear Mr. Mudd:

It is my understanding that you wish to discharge eleven (11) 55 gallon drums of groundwater from the referenced site into the City of Orlando's sanitary sewer system.

Also, it is my understanding that discharges will occur on during the week of March 11, 1996.

Based upon a review of analytical data from each well, and a recent site visit, it has been determined that the above referenced drums can be discharged to the sanitary sewer system under the current guidelines established within the City of Orlando's Sanitary Sewer Use Ordinance (Chapter 30), and your Industrial User Discharge Permit (CO62QA).
