**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON PROPOSED ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION AT THE NAVAL TRAINING CENTER (NTC), ORLANDO**  
An environmental response has been proposed for the former North Grinder Landfill site at NTC Orlando's Main Base. This area has been designated as Operable Unit (OU) 1 in the ongoing Installation Restoration environmental program at NTC. The proposed action, described in detail in the draft Proposed Plan for OU 1 report, includes: groundwater monitoring to evaluate water quality and chemistry and determine changes in the water table which may affect contaminant movement; visual landfill inspections to assess the adequacy of the existing landfill soil cover; and institutional controls including deed, land use, and groundwater use restrictions which will notify future users of environmental conditions at the site. A community meeting to discuss the OU 1 proposal will be held on May 22, 1997 at 7:00 p.m. at the Orlando City Hall's Agenda Conference Room (second floor), 400 South Orange Avenue, Orlando. Environmental specialists will provide a briefing on the proposed action, followed by a public comment and question period. All comments will be considered in the final Proposed Plan for the site. A public comment period on the draft OU 1 Proposed Plan will also be held from May 15, 1997 to June 16, 1997.
