Dear Mr. Sanford:

I have completed my review of the Groundwater Sampling Reports for Operable Unit 3, Study Areas 8 and 9, Third Quarter 2003 through Third and Fourth Quarter 2007, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated January 2004, April 2004, June 2004, September 2004, February 2005, March 2005, July 2005, September 2005, February 2006, March 2006, July 2006, October 2006, December 2006, April 2007, September 2007, January 2008, August 2008, respectively (received April 5, 2004; May 18, 2004; June 10, 2004; October 7, 2004; February 17, 2005; April 14, 2005; August 1, 2005; October 3, 2005; March 1, 2006; April 5, 2006; July 13, 2006; October 16, 2006; February 5, 2007; April 25, 2007; September 24, 2007; January 31, 2008; and August 29, 2008, respectively), prepared and submitted by Terraine, Inc. This letter is to acknowledge the Department's receipt of these reports and to verify that the information contained within those reports is acceptable to the Department. The reports adequately document the results of groundwater monitoring conducted at the site, including the difficulties encountered with monitoring wells being destroyed, filled with sand, covered by fill material, seasonally being either submerged or going dry, or otherwise being disturbed by construction activities associated with development activities at Baldwin Park. The data contained in the reports are reflective of what was discussed at Orlando Naval Training Center Partnering meetings and the conclusions and recommendations located

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within the reports support and mirror discussions and decisions made at those meeting. Please verify that the recommendations of the last report regarding abandoning monitoring well OLD-08-29, and if necessary OLD-08-04 and OLD-08-08, locating monitoring well OLD-08-17 or replacing it, and discontinuing analyzing for herbicides at Study Area 9, have been implemented or are scheduled to be implemented. Groundwater monitoring has been conducted in accordance with an Interim Record of Decision (IROD) the Department concurred with on January 31, 2001. Pursuant to that IROD, the activities conducted thus far at Operable Unit 3, Study Areas 8 and 9 should be evaluated to determine whether they need to be continued, expanded, modified or terminated in furtherance of a final proposed remedy for the sites that is protective of human health and the environment and complies with Department regulations.
