Dear Mr. Ugolini:

I have completed the review of Closure Assessment Report for UST 2115 at Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated June 1999 (received June 15, 1999), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I cannot concur with the consultant's recommendation for No Further Action as benzo(a)pyrene was detected in a soil sample at a concentration greater than its residential and industrial soil cleanup target level (SCTL). Although it is appreciated that contaminants were not detected with an Organic Vapor Analyzer at concentrations that would indicate a petroleum release, any detection of a contaminant at concentrations greater than its SCTL is grounds to perform a Site Assessment to determine the nature and extent of contamination. Site Assessment activities at this site should be conducted in accordance with Chapter 62-770, Florida Administrative Code, and a Site Assessment Report prepared and submitted.
