

I have completed the review of Closure Assessment Report for AST 129 at Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated June 1999 (received June 15, 1999), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The Tank Closure Assessment Report did not indicate a discharge of petroleum. Therefore, you are not required to conduct site assessment activities at this site in accordance with Chapter 62-770, Florida Administrative Code, for this storage tank. However, as site assessment activities have already occurred at this site and have indicated the presence of contaminants in groundwater at concentrations above their applicable groundwater cleanup target levels, further site assessment activities should continue at this site.
