

I have completed the review of the Source Removal Reports for Buildings 7171, 7175 and 7241, Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated June 1999 (received July 1, 1999), prepared and submitted by Harding Lawson Associates. The reports are acceptable for their intent. I concur with the consultant's recommendations that SARs be prepared for Buildings 7171 and 7175. However, I cannot concur with the consultant's recommendation for No Further Action for Building 7241. Further Site Assessment at Building 7241 is warranted to confirm that all petroleum impacted soil has been removed by the Environmental Detachment - Charleston and also to confirm there are no longer any impacts to groundwater.
