



I have completed the review of Tank Closure Assessment Report for ASTs 109, 128-3, 200, 386, 2006, 2011-1, 2011-2, 2011-3, 2025, 2076, 2091-1, 2091-2, 2266, 2405, 2420, 4053 and 7151-1 at Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated June 1999 (received June 15, 1999), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Additional information was requested in a July 8, 1999 letter. With the requested information having been received by facsimile, the disposal receipts on August 26, 1999 and the OVA Flame Ionization Detector readings on September 1, 1999, the Tank Closure Assessment Report adequately documents that the aboveground storage tanks listed above are not contaminated by petroleum products.
