UST/IR/Transfer Updates

UST/IR: See handout (updates are bold/italicized in the handout) and action items developed during discussion.

Transfer:

- Washington disappointed only 1.6 acres transferred last month.
- Looking to transfer communication building at Herndon this month.
- Working on deeds for FAA conveyance at Herndon and McCoy.
- Public benefit conveyance to city at McCoy.
- Part of multi-modal area will be going to city instead of GOAA.
- VA has requested Area C. City has recently shown some interest as well.

SA 35, 40, 54 Update

SA 35 has been delineated and area has been dug out. Testing fill dirt prior to filling in hole.

SA 40 results were handed out. Did not show full delineation of arsenic. This led to taking a more aggressive approach. Gridded out ball park areas. We are looking to possibly mix/blend site to remediate site to residential SCTLs. Debris may preclude mixing/blending scenario.

SA 54 sample results were handed out. Only two samples are left to be analyzed, sample points 85 and 88. Some samples have had as much as 20,000 ppb PAHs.

OU 1 Monitoring

Steve T. handed out monitoring result sheets for December 1999 and June 2000. Two foot drop in gw elevations between December 1999 and June 2000, probably due to the drought. Because there was only a couple of feet of water in some of the shallow wells and because water came out very turbid, showed higher concentrations, especially OLD-U1-22A. There was a shallow depression (sinkhole) noted in parking lot area. Another, smaller depression was noted in June 2000, measuring 10' by 10' by 1 foot deep. Someone is putting in wells outside of the fenced area.

OU 3 Treatability Study (Column Studies)

Activated Alumina was the definite winner. Pretty much handled all the arsenic that was thrown at it. Iron modified zeolite was close to the saturation point after several days.

OU 3 IROD Response to Comments

Rick handed out Response to Comments letter. Team to look at e-mailed redline/strikeout version of IROD to make sure suggested changes were made in the IROD.

RAB preparation – OU 4 retrofit, SA 39 IRA, SA 2 ORC

Discussed slides to be presented at the RAB meeting.

17 August 2000

Training

Stephanie discussed the dynamics of type as theorized by Jung. Team failed test with the 13 nails.

IDW Update

58 drums left after last meeting, 6 of which we had disposal data on, 52 of which we needed to collect data. We will be generating approximately 50 drums with work with SA 36, and they will be disposed of by end of next week. All but 1 or 2 drums on Herndon Annex that were generated by GOAA have been removed by the city. Have several old drums associated with 7174 that need to be disposed of. HLA to find the old SAR for the site and get data to Steve.

Action Item: HLA to get old SAR data for 7174 to TetraTech so TetraTech can dispose of drums.

SA 17 update

Steve T. handed out confirmatory sampling data report and SA 17 injection points packet (3 pages). CH2M Hill has decided upon Geo-Cleanse to be the vendor for the Fenton's reagent work. Schedule is to start the injection point work in approximately 2 weeks and to start the injection in late September.

Golf Course Remediation field Trip

OU 4 permanganate study, FS costs for OU 4

Mark Salvetti gave a short presentation. Two issues to be dealt with when we go full scale. 1. well clogging 2. excess solids. Mark would like to submit final FS at the end of September after the team reviews a letter report with the major changes to the FS (chem. Ox changes).

OU 4 Interception wells

Teleconference call to discuss interception well and basis of design.

OU 2 DPT results

Steve M. gave short presentation. Did not detect any VOCs in any of the DPT points just sampled. Checked previously hot well and the subcontractor only found 2.5 ppb TCE. Data is very suspect. They have resampled monitoring well 18B (prev. hot well) to check to see if contamination is similar to what was detected previously.

SA 39 update

Steve T. gave short presentation. Still some issues, mostly in how we are going to inject the oil.

SA 2 ORC

Steve M. gave his ORC presentation.

Action Item: Steve M. to get team Oak Ridge hotel information for next meeting.
