I have completed my review of the BRAC Environmental Site Screening Report for Study Area 35 (SA 35), Main Base, dated December 2000 (received December 19, 2000), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Surface soil contamination has been successfully remediated as to pose minimal risk to potential future site residents. I concur with the recommendation that this parcel be reclassified from 7/Gray to 4/Dark Green and that SA 35 be made eligible for transfer with no requirements for institutional controls on the property.
