I have completed my review of the Source Removal Report for Study Area 16, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated September 2000 (received October 2, 2000), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The removal report adequately documents the excavation and disposal of petroleum contaminated soils at Study Area 16. I concur with the consultant's recommendation that no further action is required for areas surrounding locations HLA16S009, HLA16S011 and HLA15S014. I also concur with the recommendation to pursue further investigation in the drainage ditches to the east and south of SA 16 where PAHs have been detected above Soil Cleanup Target Levels.
