

Dear Mr. Ugolini:

I have completed the review of the Site Assessment Report (SAR) for Building 2115, Main Base, Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated November 2000 (received November 30, 2000), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Based upon my review, I concur with the consultant's recommendation to perform another round of groundwater sampling and analysis prior to determining if the monitoring only for natural attenuation should be the selected remedy for this site. I believe temporary monitoring well 2115-T01 should be sampled as well as 2115-MW01. That temporary monitoring well had detected TRPH contamination slightly below the Department's groundwater cleanup target level and while it is not directly downgradient of source well 2115-MW01, it is in the downgradient direction. Please note, a permanent monitoring well in compliance with GCTLs will need to be installed directly downgradient of source well 2115-MW01 as part of a monitoring only plan for this site.
