

I have completed my review of the Technical Memorandum, Soil Investigation Summary, Study Area 36, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated January 16, 2002 (received January 22, 2002), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report adequately describes the confirmatory soil sampling conducted by Tetra Tech NUS that indicates that soil contamination greater than Florida Soil Cleanup Target Levels is not present at Study Area 36. Based upon this report, the boundary of Study Area 36 may be redefined to only include that area where the contaminated groundwater plume exists. The Orlando Partnering Team agreed to the plume boundary for Study Area 36 at the June 4-6, 2002 partnering meeting.
