

I have completed my review of the Site Screening Report for Study Area 40, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated June 2002 (received June 5, 2002), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report adequately describes the various investigations conducted at the site and the remedial responses to the contamination detected. Contaminated soil that has been excavated on three different occasions has apparently reduced the risks at the site so as to be protective of a residential user. Therefore, I concur that no further action is warranted at this site and that the site may be transferred without land use restrictions.

FDEP's concurrence is predicated on the information provided by the SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM. Therefore, any new information contradicting the basis for this concurrence, may require further investigation or remedial actions.
