The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the subject document.

GENERAL COMMENT

1. **There are a few occurrences of TCE in the south plume, and of these, the highest concentration is at OLD-OU2-18B. This report presents the 250 µg/L concentration at this well which is down from last concentration of 1,200 µg/L, July 1999. This point is directly adjacent to a canal in the southern portion of the site. The report does indicate that surface water samples were collected but there are no figures showing those locations. Please provide a figure for the location of surface water sample collection locations. Additionally, a surface water sample should be collected in the future adjacent to well OLD-OU2-18B as the high concentrations of TCE are most probably discharging to this surface water body.**

SPECIFIC COMMENT

1. **Section 3.5, page 5 & 6, NA Parameter Summary Tables. The tables are separated into upgradient, in plume and downgradient. If this is so, where do Wells 21A and B belong? They are listed both as in the plume and downgradient from the plume. Also, it is not clear how these areas are defined. Please revise the text as appropriate.**
