

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection concurs with the Navy's decision that no further action to address contamination at Study Area 18, McCoy Annex, Orlando Naval Training Center is required. Soil excavations have remediated site conditions such that the site is suitable for unrestricted use. Groundwater contamination from site activities does not appear to be present at concentrations exceeding regulatory criteria.
