

Dear Mrs. Nwokike:

I have completed my review of the Operable Unit 1 and Operable Unit 3 Recommendations, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated May 11, 2005 (received May 13, 2005), prepared and submitted by Terraine, Inc. The report recommends that analysis for herbicides in groundwater at Operable Unit 3, Study Area 8, be discontinued and that analyses for herbicides and pesticides in groundwater at Operable Unit 1 be discontinued as well. While I concur that these analyses can be discontinued, I would ask that the tables used in support for this decision be fixed. The tables in many locations show the Method Detection Limits as being greater than or equal to the Practical Quantitation Limits, which is incorrect. Please resubmit the corrected tables.
