

Monitoring well MW-8 and MW-10 should be sampled on a quarterly basis for a period of one year. Groundwater samples should be analyzed using U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Method 610 and for total recoverable petroleum hydrocarbons using Florida-Petroleum Residual Organic analysis.
