I have completed my review of the Technical Memorandum, Study Area 36NW Groundwater Data Summary, Former Naval Training Center Orlando, dated April 22, 2014 (received April 25, 2014), prepared and submitted by Resolution Consultants. The purpose of the report was to summarize the history of groundwater contaminant concentrations at Study Area 36NW to determine whether multi-chamber monitoring well OLD-38-58 should be replaced because the C-2 chamber was found to be plugged during the June 2013 sampling event. The information provided was sufficient to make the determination that the well should be replaced. A multi-chamber well need not be installed. A typical monitoring well screened in the C-2 zone (40-45 feet below ground surface) and installed in the vicinity of OLD-38-58 would suffice.
