**SUBJECT:** Permitted water supply wells in vicinity of CSS Panama City

Sandra is the database person at WMD. I asked if I could determine if there were wells presently being used for water supply near the CSS Panama City. She responded that she can pull up complete permit/ownership/location/construction records for all wells that the WMD has permitted since their DB was established in 1976. Their records include repairs and abandonments.

The DB is indexed by township and by permit date. I can obtain a database report for any township @ a cost of \$5 each. To get a handle on the potential scope of the report, I asked her to run a search for all domestic wells--there are 5585 permitted wells (they may not be in use, and it is likely that perhaps a few hundred are abandoned, according to her) domestic wells in Bay County, 70 public wells, and 191 "limited-use public supply wells", which are regulated by the FL HRS (Dept. of Health & Rehabilitative Services), which typically serve trailer parks.

We hung up with me agreeing to determine which townships I wanted to get reports for, and to call her back on Monday June 6.
