Under the Department of Defense Installation Restoration Program, the Navy has completed an Initial Assessment Study (IAS) of the Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida. This IAS is the first phase in the Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP) program.
