Under the Department of Defense Installation Restoration Program, the Navy has completed the verification study in the assessment of potential ground water pollution at the Naval Air Station, Pensacola, Florida. The final report is enclosed. This study is the second phase in the Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP) Program.

Sixteen inactive sites were selected for the verification study. Because of the grouping of some of these sites, these sixteen sites have been consolidated into eleven sites for this report. Five of these eleven sites have been selected for further characterization under the NACIP Program. Work recommended in this study will be started by January 1985.
