Dear Mr. Spell:

Thank *you* for *carbon copying* EPA on your letter (copy attached) to Mr. Thomas Moody, Florida Department of Environmental Regulation (FLDER), in which you requested an extension to October 8, 1985 for sitting a completed "Solid Waste Questionnaire". This information was requested by Florida Department of Environmental Regulations on behalf of EPA under *the* authority of Section 3004U of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (HSWA) in a letter dated March 26, 1985. The Navy had sixty (60) days or until May 31, 1985 to respond. We are granting an extension until July 1, 1984 for submittal of the required Section 3004U information. The completed questionnaire should be sent to FLDER as originally requested.

According to *you?*: letter and Mr. McCauley in the subject telephone conversation, there was some confusion because on March 22, 1985, EPA and FLDER also requested the complete Part B application for the subject facility. Today's letter does not change the October 8, 1985 due date for the Part B application.
