Dear Mr. Pike:

This is in response to your letter dated January 14, 1986 which enclosed information to satisfy conditions 18(b) and (c) of Temporary Operation Permit BT17-68087.

The Corrective Action Plan is approved with the following modifications:


1. The proposed deep monitor well east of the polishing pond should have a 10-15 foot screen rather than the 5 foot screen.
2. The recovery-well system should continue operation until an asymptotic condition is reached.

The Ground Water Monitoring Plan to be used during corrective action is approved. Upon completion of corrective action the requirements specified in Rule 17-4 must be met. The plan as submitted does not propose a zone of discharge, a proper monitoring protocol, and well designations that meet this rule. These modifications should be submitted to the Department upon completion of the corrective action program.

Closure Permit applications for the surge pond and sludge drying beds should be submitted to the Department in accordance with Rule 17-30.26. A construction permit application for the tanks should be submitted to the Department in accordance with Rule 17-30.25.
