Dear Mr. Kellenberger:

As discussed between you and Mr. Mike Green on 17 February 1989, the monitoring of the monitor wells (for the surface impoundments of the Wastewater Treatment Plant at NAS Pensacola) is behind schedule. The monitoring is being managed by the Installation Restoration Program at Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, as part of the interim remedial measures applied to the sites. Primary attention of the IRP has recently been directed towards obtaining a long-term contract to provide for investigation, study, and design of remedial actions for all sites of contamination at NAS Pensacola (including the Wastewater Treatment Plant site); programmed funding was expended for those purposes and funds for monitoring were delayed. Net result has been a delay in contracting for the required sampling in February 1989; every effort is being made to obtain the contractual services as soon as possible. As soon as the contract action is finalized, you will be advised of the schedule for the sampling event. We regret the delay and will take steps to ensure future groundwater monitoring is performed on schedule.
