Dear Ms. Dean:

This letter is in response to your letter of October 11, 1989 regarding EPA's proposed schedule for negotiations and finalization of the FFA's. A copy of EPA's original draft FFA/IAG was received by the Navy on October 2, however the official Draft FFA was not received by this command until October 13.

As discussed during the first negotiation meeting in Atlanta, Georgia on October 17 and 18, the Navy will be available for a second negotiation meeting during the week of November 13, based on your present schedule of providing a revised Draft by October 31. It is the Navy's request that the next negotiation meeting continue until the Parties have resolved all issues in the Agreements at the regional level. If the above request conflicts with schedules of any other party, however, the Navy is willing to meet at the availability of that Party.

The Navy is unable to commit to any other dates in your proposed schedule for FFA negotiations, since all of the proposed dates are contingent upon the successfulness of future negotiations and the delivery of revised Agreements by EPA.

The Navy is committed to achieving a Federal Facilities Agreement with EPA and FDER for its three Naval activities proposed for the MFL in Florida, as quickly as possible. Please contact Ms. Monique Williams at (800) 743-3000 and confirm the date and location of the next negotiation meeting.
