NOTICE OF INTENT TO EXECUTE  
FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the U.S. Department of Navy (DON), and the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation (FDER) declare their intent to execute the Federal Facility Agreement for NAS Cecil Field Site (Agreement). The Parties agree that:

Within fifteen (15) days of the execution of this Notice, the Parties shall: (1) publish this notice of intent to execute the Agreement; and (2) make available for review by the public copies of the Agreement and all appendices.

The Parties shall accept written comments for a period of forty-five (45) days following publication of this Notice. After the close of the comment period, the Parties will review and respond to such comments. The Parties will determine whether the comments disclose facts or considerations which indicate that the proposed Agreement is inappropriate, improper or inadequate. The Parties shall execute the Agreement when these public participation requirements have been completed.
