Dear Mr. Scarbrough:

This letter is to provide notification that the Navy will consent to allow EPA oversight of analytical laboratories at Navy sites on the National Priorities List (**NPL**). **As** stated in your letter of **21** May 1990, it is understood that EPA will provide one spike and one blank for each media, up to a maximum of **six** samples at each facility during the remedial investigations. The spikes and blanks will be substituted for blind sample spikes and blanks already proposed by the contractors for work at the facilities, and will be analyzed for parameters proposed for the environmental samples for each media.

Please coordinate submission of the spikes and blanks, and collection of the split samples with the scheduled field sampling events at each facility. In accordance with the negotiated Federal Facility Agreements, the Navy will provide a **21** day notification to you prior to sample collection.
