Dear Mr. Criswell:

Per Section XXXV of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) for Naval Air Station Pensacola, EPA is notifying the Navy of the execution of the FFA on October 23, 1990. Schedules and deadlines under this Agreement commence on November 1, 1990. Please be aware that the Site Management Plan (SMP) is due 30 days from the effective date of November 1, 1990.

This letter also serves to inform you of EPA's acceptance of your previous submission in October 1990 of a draft final Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan and supporting secondary documents as the draft final Phase I RI/FS Work Plan required as a primary document under the FFA. EPA concurred with the Phase I RI/FS Work Plan and conditionally approved the supporting Quality Assurance Project Plan on October 18, 1990. EPA also accepts the draft final Community Relations Plan received on October 22, 1990 and will respond per the schedule in the FFA.
