Dear Captain Burns:


A Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) with Naval Air Station Pensacola, was executed on October 23, 1990. In accordance with the FFA an annual Site Management Plan (SMP) will be submitted with a yearly enforcement schedule for subsequent years.

Because of this new schedule, EPA is revising the corrective actions schedule under Permit Number FL9170024567, issued pursuant to the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, as amended, in accordance with Section II.G.6, which reads "All plans and schedules shall be subject to approval by the Regional Administrator prior to implementation. The Permittee shall revise all submittals and schedules as specified by the Regional Administrator and implement all plans and schedules, as written, upon approval." From the date of this letter all schedules under the permit will be in accordance with those approved in the SMP under the FFA.

In accordance with Section XXIII of the FFA, the SMP is to be submitted to EPA and the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation within thirty (30) calendar days of the Effective Date of the FFA.
