Naval Air Station Pensacola is proposing to dispose of Investigative Derived Waste (IDW) generated during Remedial Investigations in accordance with EPA guidance document EPA/540/G-91/009 Management of Investigation-Derived Wastes During Site Inspections.

The disposal options selected in accordance with section 4.5 of the EPA guidance document are:

- For soil cuttings: Spread around the well
- For decontamination fluids: Dispose of at Xndustrial Wastewater Treatment Plant .
- For decontaminated personal protective equipment: Double bag and deposit in municipal landfill.
