
Dear Ms. Martin:

EPA Region IV is currently in the process of completing its review of the Draft RI/FS Work Plans for Operable Units 6 through 9 (Batch 2), which were received in this office on April 17, 1992. We regret that due to the volume of documents submitted for simultaneous review and the capacity of our internal technical review process for dealing with such reviews, we will not be supplying comments within the 90-day review period stipulated in Section VIII.G.3. of the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA).

This letter shall therefore serve as our written notice of intent to extend review period by 20 days, also per Section VIII.G.3. of the FFA. We anticipate providing comments to the Navy on the aforementioned work plans by August 5, 1992 at the latest.
