**SUBJECT:** Review of Draft/Final document submittals for Batch 4 (Groups H, I, P, and Q) incorporating FDER comments. July 1992. Pensacola Naval Air Station

I have reviewed the above referenced documents and have the following comments:

- 1.- **As** discussed during the RPM Meeting of June 16-17, the Department would like to do away with **compositing** soil samples over five foot intervals. Based on EPA's definition of surface soil samples as those obtained from 0 to 1 feet below land surface, it was agreed that corrections would be made to all the groups, however, those corrections seem to be missing from Groups H and Q. Please correct Sections 14.1.3.2 accordingly.
- 2.- **As** agreed during the June 16-17 RPM Meeting, the Department would conditionally approve the Draft Final RI/FS Workplans if fieldwork related issues had been taken care of. With the exception of the comment referenced above, and since our comments issued on November 4, 1991 have been adequately addressed, the Documents should be considered approved. Please note, as agreed during the June 16-17 RPM Meeting, the workplans regarding this batch will be discussed amongst the three FFA parties prior to field work initiation to assure expediency and to prevent any misunderstandings regarding the assessment approach and **Data** Quality Objectives.
