QUARTERLY PROGRESS REPORT

FOURTH QUARTER. 1992

1 JULY 1992 - 30 SEPTEMBER 1992

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background : A Federal Facilities Agreement (**FFA**) was signed by the **U.S.** Navy, the Environmental Protection Agency (**EPA**), and the State of Florida via the Florida department of Environmental Regulation on October 23, 1990. The FFA requires the Navy to submit to the other FFA parties on a quarterly basis a Quarterly Progress Report (**QPR**).

1.2 Scope : As provided for in FFA Part XII, Reporting, the QPR identifies and briefly describes the actions which the Navy has taken to implement FFA requirements in the previous quarter and those actions scheduled in the upcoming quarter. The activity narratives should include a statement on the manner and extent to which the Navy is meeting the schedules provided by the FFA in its Site Management Plan (**SMP**) and in the approved work plans. In addition to activity descriptions, any problems that caused delays or anticipated problems that might cause delays are identified and the actions the Navy has or **plans** to take to manage the delays are discussed.

1.3 Schedule : The Navy is to transmit the QPR within **30** days of the end of the previous quarter.

2. FFA ACTIVITIES

2.1 SITE MANAGEMENT PLAN

2.1.1 On 1 September 1992 the Navy submitted the 1993 Yearly SMP to the EPA and FDER for review.

2.2 ADMINISTRATION

2.2.1 In a letter dated 6 July 1992 the Navy **requested** that the EPA postpone **sampling** at NAS Pensacola until the Navy receives a SHSP and a field sampling workplan to review. In a letter dated 3 August 1992 EPA stated that they had already submitted a Draft Study Plan for a field investigation to be conducted the week of 13 July 1992.

2.2.2 In a letter dated 15 July 1992 EPA submitted a written notice of intent to extend the review period for the Draft RI/FS Workplans: OUs 6 - 9 by 20 days to 5 August 1992.

2.2.3 In a letter dated 28 August 1992 EPA proposed a **revised** schedule for completing the Interim ROD and associated decision documents for OU 10.

2.2.4 The NAS Pensacola sent EPA a **letter** dated 15 September 1992 **stating** its decision to dispose of Investigative Derived Waste soil cuttings at a permitted hazardous waste landfill.

2.2.5 The Navy completed a reorganization of the contaminated sites by separating them into **seven** categories. Each category contains operable units and potential screening sites.

2.2.6 SOW 33 and 34 were negotiated in September.

3.0 SITE WORK ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

3.1 The Navy received Monthly Progress Reports from EnSafe.

3.2 The Navy received Monthly Progress Reports and Overall Project Status Summaries for the Contamination Assessment/Remedial Activities Investigations at NAS Pensacola from Ecology and Environment.

3.3 EnSafe submitted the Final Draft Health and Safety Plan on 9 September 1992 to the Navy for review and comment. Comments received on 28 September 1992 were incorporated into the Final Health and Safety Plan delivered to the Navy 30 September 1992.

3.4 A site visit was conducted by the EnSafe for CTO-048 on 2 July 1992 to orient personnel for workplan development in OUs 15, 16, and 17.

3.5 In a letter dated 8 July 1992 EPA approved the Navy's "Immediate Removal Action Contingency Plan."

3.6 EnSafe provided the Navy with review comments of Ecology and Environment's Data Summary and Preliminary Scoping for Ecological Risk Assessment Workplans in a letter dated 15 July 1992.

3.7 The Navy received comments from NOM on the Draft Data Summary and Preliminary Scoping for Ecological Risk Assessment Work Plans on 17 July 1992.

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- 3.8 In a letter dated 17 July 1992 the Navy received approval on the **Data Summary** and Preliminary Scoping for Ecological Risk Assessment Work Plans from FDER.
- 3.9 **EnSafe** submitted the Draft Health and Safety Plan to the Navy on 27 July 1992.
- 4.0 The Navy received comments from FDER on **Draft/Final** document submittals for Batch 4 (Groups H, I, P, and Q) on 3 August 1992.
- 4.1 EPA conditionally approved the Draft Final **RI/FS** Workplans for **OUs 11 - 14** in a letter dated 11 August 1992.
- 4.2 **EnSafe** completed the Draft Sampling and **Analysis** Plan for **OU-10** on 12 August 1992.
- 4.3 On 18 August 1992 the Navy submitted the revised Community Relations Plan to EPA.
- 4.4 On 19 August 1992 the Navy received review comments from the EPA on the Data Summary and Preliminary Scoping for Ecological Risk Assessment Workplans.
- 4.5 In a letter dated 24 August 1992 the Navy submitted the **Draft/Final Workplan** for Group **I**; (Site 4, 5, 6, and 16) and the **Draft/Final** Generic Plans (PMP, SMP, GHSP, and QUAPP) for NAS Pensacola to EPA and FDER and Natural Resource Trustees.
- 4.6 The Navy received review comments from EPA on the **Draft RI/FS** Workplans for Operable Units **6-9** on 13 August 1992.
- 4.7 The Navy received approval for the Final Contamination **Assessment/Remedial** Activities Work Plan Group **L**, Health and Safety Plan and Generic Quality Assurance Project Plan from FDER on 1 September 1992.
- 4.8 The Navy received conditional approval of the Draft Final **RI/FS** Workplans for **OUs 1-5** in a letter dated 1 September 1992 from EPA.
- 4.9 An RPM and a TRC meeting were held at NAS Pensacola on September 9 and 10, 1992.
- 5.0 On 18 September 1992 the Navy received comments from EPA on the Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan for Operable Unit 10.
- 5.1 On 24 September 1992 the Navy received comments from NOAA on **the documents** listed in Appendix A.
- 5.2 On 25 September 1992 Ecology and **Environment** submitted the Draft July 1992 Semiannual Report on Groundwater Monitoring, Wastewater Treatment Facility to the Navy.

5.3 The Navy received comments from FDER on the Draft **Sampling and Analysis Plan** for **Operable** Unit 10.

5.4 The Navy received monthly operation and maintenance reports on the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Plant Groundwater Remediation from Ecology and Environment, Inc.

4.1 Update the 1993 SMP.

4.2 Transfer underground storage tanks to CERCLA.

4.3 Fieldwork will begin at OU-10 in early November.
